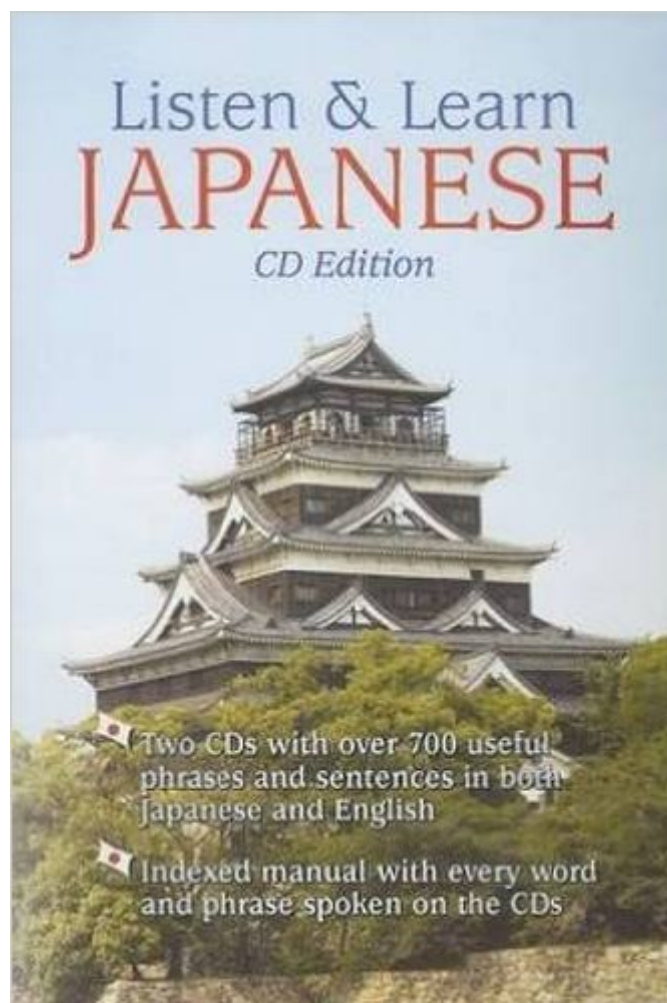

I listened to both CDS last night and was very impressed. There are many many phrases that go above and beyond the usual "Where is the train station?" The narration is done by both M and F voices and sound less stilted than Pimsleur CDS. In addition there are several conversations spoken at normal speed. Most of the phrases are advanced beginner and intermediate level. "Is there a transfer at Hiroshima" and "I would like to order something not too sweet" are examples of the level of difficulty. The phrases seem to be taken from Dover's "Say It In Japanese" which is a great book BTW. The only quibble I have -- the pamphlet is stapled (not bound) and the small kanji
