Used this for a Pre-K lesson over Community Helpers. Talks about addressing mail & how the mail is sent & received. Perfect book for introducing & teaching young children about Mail Carriers.

My 4 year old is in a service trucks phase. Mail trucks, garbage trucks, UPS and Fedex. He had to have this! A bit thin for the price but he loves it. The graphics are very plain though. Had I seen the inside prior to purchase, I wouldn't have gotten it.

I read this today to the first to third grade kids in my stamp club. The ages are about six to ten years old. The kids enjoyed this book and it was an easy read. The pages are large and I was able to easily read this to a group of 8 kids without any moving around or complaints that the kids couldn't see well. The book covered the basic jobs of the mail carrier (of course) and a few extra little pointers about the mail service, in general, in the back. I could the simple 1-2 sentences a page made reading and asking questions from the kids easy. The pictures gave just as much info as the

words did. For example, there was an image of the postal carrier delivering mail from the right side of the truck - "the mail carrier drives on the same side as the curb" This one sentence and photo sparked a 5 minute conversation about safety, why the mail company doesn't pay for two drivers, the increased cost of stamps for extra labor, etc. The photo of the mail carrier on the back had the kids laughing and asking about mail carriers on islands in Alaska. I'm glad we picked this book up. The kids really enjoyed it. I would highly recommend this for the PreK-3 group.

I bought this to go with the Melissa and Doug mailbox. Pages have short sentences, simple and just right for younger children. My child is 3. Great illustrations.

I used it for teaching a lesson on mail delivery and was very pleased with the amount of information presented. Easy to read. Appropriate for a 1st grader.

I adore this book and it brings the concept and sense of community workers and people working together. you learn the different job of mailmen, their routes, what side the steering wheel is on and why and about safety around mail trucks. it's a good book especially if a parent or neighbor is a mailman or anyone the child(s) know. I hope you get to view the inside. the description and summary ON THE BOOK cover is very loose and gives it no justice.

Most small children love interesting cars and trucks, and mail trucks are definitely on that list. If your little one is looking to learn more about mail trucks and how the mail is delivered, "Delivering the Mail" is a great book. It has simple illustrations that draw kids in, and it is written using clear words and language that younger children will be able to understand.
