

The book is well enough written that it conveys the history and sense of the time without becoming too dry and historical. Some parts of this Magellan story, which I recall from other reading, are pretty brutal. The author doesn't ignore the rough life and brutality of the 16th century, he just doesn't dwell upon it. The story advances without a lot of contemporary judgments. The story also has links to the present by pointing out that... in year's to come, this place became known as... for example. I hope the boys begin to appreciate history more as they read and ask questions about the Magellan story.
